FORMAT OPTIONS- PICK YOUR FORMAT

FORMAT 1

Modified Scramble - Each player plays a ball from the tee. The team selects the best position from which to play their second shots. Players should play their individual ball for the remainder of each hole.

As for scoring your team may count the same ball for net and gross scores, as they are two separate events. The max score for any hole is a **net double bogey**. (Each player will receive 50% of their adjusted course handicap.)

FORMAT 2

Four Person Scramble - Each player tees off on each hole and the team decides on which location to scramble from. Every player then plays their second shot from within a club length of where the best shot has come to rest and the procedure is repeated until the hole is finished. The ball must be played from the same condition (example: fairway, rough, hazard.) **The max score on any hole will be a double bogey.**

Tees: Men will play from the Sponsor Signs. If unable to play from the set tees, please move forward. Women will play from the Fox Tees.

Rules: Unites States Golf Association (U.S.G.A.) rules will govern all play along with the following local rules:

- 1. Play the native areas (defined as native grasses and scrub oak) as a Red Penalty Area
 - a. Take two club lengths from entry point for relief. Add one penalty stroke.
- 2. In case of a cancellation due to poor weather conditions, your first 9 holes will be used to determine the winner (the most under par.) If a tie still exists a card draw will determine the order of finish.

Ties: Ties will be decided by a sudden death scorecard playoff beginning with hole #1 until a winner is determined.

SANCTUARY

Sanctuary is played exclusively by invitation or through one of the approximately 25 charity events hosted annually. It is known for its elevated tees, towering pines and 180-degree mountain views encompassing Pikes Peak to the South and Longs Peak to the North. Because of the dramatic terrain, a foursome typically feels the entire course is theirs—even when play is at capacity. Five sets of tees invite every level of play.
